4. PERSONNAL CONTACT PROGRAMME (PCP) FOR ALL BATCHES FROM 20-03-2020 TO 30-03-2020 AT SCHOOL OF DISTANCE EDUCATION –ANDHRA UNIVERSITY VISAKHAPATNAM


As per the regulations attendance at the PTP and PCP is compulsory and the students are not eligible to take the University examinations without attending the PTP and PCP. In the Practical Training Programme the student has to visit 10 Cooperative Societies in five days and they have to write two records on the visit. Students have to prepare to stay for five days for the visit. During the Personal Contact programme (PCP), students have to stay 11days. Experienced University teachers will deliver regular classroom lectures in all subjects. The classes will be conducted at School of Distance Education building between 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.

The candidates of previous batches, who could not attend the PTP and PCP classes, are also required to attend the programme so as to make them eligible to take the University examinations along with current batch of students.

The students have to register their names on the first day at their respective centers at 9.00 a.m. Time-table and other details of the programme will be furnished at time of registration.
