

**Research Activities:** A total of 25 research publications have been published by our faculty in several peer reviewed and SCOPUS, Web of Science indexed journals during this period. All our faculty are actively engaged in carrying out DST, AICTE, UGC projects and 12 projects are in progress. During this period blended mode of teaching was adopted by the faculty to deliver their class lectures to students. Almost all the faculty have prepared e-materials for their classes and they are counselling/motivating students during this testing hours of pandemic.

Many research scholars are also actively engaged in research and a few have attended several workshops/training programs. 7 research scholars from AU College of science & technology, 6 from AUCE(A), 1 from Pharmacy and 2 from College of Law have attended several conferences to upgrade their knowledge.

As per QS, an International ranking agency, the following are the scores by indicators released during QS ASIA 2021 Rankings. Based on the scores obtained Andhra University was ranked in 351-400 rank.
